This is the last Will and Testa-  
ment of me Noble Jones of Savannah in the  
Province of Georgia Esquire which I do now make  
being weak in body but of sound perfect and disposing  
mind and memory. That is to say / First I will  
that all such Debts as I shall justly owe at the time of  
my decease and my Funeral Charges and Expences  
be in the first place paid by my Executors herein after  
named and direct that they may inter me in a decent  
plain manner without putting my Estate to any Extra-  
ordinary Expences for the same Item I give and  
Devise unto my Daughter Mary Jones all that my  
Plantation or Tract of Land containing Five hun-  
dred Acres known by the name of Wormulow situate  
and being at the South End of the Isle of Hope in the  
Parish of Christ Church in the Province aforesaid  
which said Plantation was originally Granted to me  
on the ninth day of December one thousand seven  
hundred and fifty six to have and to hold the said  
Plantation or Tract of Land with the Rights Members  
and appurtenances thereof unto my said Daughter  
Mary Jones and her Assigns for and during the Term  
of her natural life without Impediment of Waste  
and from and immediately after her decease I give  
and Devise the same Plantation or Tract of Land  
with the appurtenances unto my Son Noble Wimberly  
Jones and his Heirs and Assigns forever my Will-  
and meaning being that the same do remain in  
the name and Family and the premises be kept in  
good and Sufficient Repair by such Person and

Persons as shall or may be possessed thereof Item I Give and Devise unto my said Daughter Mary Jones All that Town Lot Situate in the Town of Savannah aforesaid Together with all Houses and Improvements thereon being known by the number two in the first Tything Reynolds Ward containing Sixty feet in Front and ninety feet in Depth And also the Farm Lot thereto belonging containing Forty five Acres known by Number one in the first Tything Reynolds Ward which said Town and Farm Lots were originally Granted to me on the Sixteenth day of January one thousand seven hundred and fifty six And also all that Farm Lot containing Forty five Acres known by the number eight in Carpenter Tything Decker Ward, which by a certain Indenture of Bargain and Sale bearing date the fifteenth day of September one thousand seven hundred and fifty six Was Conveyed to me by William Scales and Frances his Wife heretofore of Savannah aforesaid both since deceased To hold the said several Town and Farm Lots with their respective Hereditaments and Appurtenances unto the said Mary Jones and her Heirs and Assigns forever Item I Give and Devise unto my said Daughter Mary Jones her Heirs and Assigns forever all that Town Lot in Savannah aforesaid known by the number one in the first Tything Reynolds Ward aforesaid containing Sixty feet in Front and Ninety feet in Depth with a Garden Lot

Situate East of the said Town known by the  
 number Fifty eight to the said Town Lot now  
 belonging / the Garden Lot number five as  
 mentioned in the said Grant having been  
 conveyed to his Excellency James Wright Esquire  
 and the said Lot number Fifty eight ordered by the  
 Governor and Council to be Indorsed on the said  
 Grant in Lieu of the said Lot Number five origi-  
 nally granted / And also the Farm Lot to the  
 said Town Lot belonging containing Forty five  
 Acres known by the number two in the first Ty-  
 thing Reynolds ward originally granted to me  
 on the Seventh day of July one thousand seven  
 hundred and Sixty one, And also I Give and  
 Devise unto my said Daughter Mary Jones and  
 her Heirs and Assigns All that Island known  
 by the name of the Redoubt Situate and being  
 in the Parish aforesaid containing Sixty three -  
 Acres be the same more or less, granted to me on  
 the Seventh day of July one thousand seven hun-  
 dred and Sixty one, Also I Give and Bequeath  
 to my said Daughter Mary the following -  
 Negroe Slaves To wit, Primus, Else, Donah, -  
 Frank, Hannah, Jemmy, Charles, Lucinda,  
 Nann, Rose, Tenah, Luke, Brutus, Grace and  
 her Child, with the future Issue & increase of  
 the said Female Slaves Also all my Plate,  
 China, Pictures and Household Furniture, -  
 whatsoever, Together with any two of my Horses  
 and my riding Chairs, Item I Give Devise  
 and Bequeath unto my Son Noble Wimberly

Jones his Heirs and Assigns forever all that -  
Tract of Land containing Three hundred Acres  
be the same more or less (being the remaining  
part of a Tract of Five hundred Acres of Land  
Situate and being at Ogechee in the Province  
aforesaid originally granted to me on the ninth  
day of December one thousand seven hundred  
and fifty six (two hundred Acres of which having  
since been sold and conveyed to Francis Harris  
of the Parish of Christ Church in the Province -  
aforesaid Esquire) Item, I Give and Devise -  
unto my said Son Noble Wimberly Jones & his -  
heirs all that Tract of Land containing Five -  
hundred Acres be the same more or less Situate  
and being on the Isle of Hope in the Parish of -  
Christ Church aforesaid (and adjoining the -  
Plantation or Tract of Land herein before men-  
tioned called by the name of Wormslow) origi-  
nally granted to me on the fourth day of Octobe  
one thousand seven hundred and Sixty three

Also I Give and Bequeath to my said Son Noble  
Wimberly Jones his Executors and Administrators  
the following negroe Slaves To wit Scipio, Gretch,  
Poole, Harvey, Adam, Mibley, Jeffrey, Kate, -  
Fanny, August, Lady, Harry, Allick, Bynah -  
and the future Issue and Increase of the said -  
Female Slaves and all my Plantation Tools -  
and Implements of Husbandry, Item I Give  
and Bequeath to my Grand Daughter Sarah, the  
wife of John Glen Esquire my negroe Slave cal-  
led Rose, together with the Issue and Increase  
of the said Female Slave, Also I Give and

Devise unto the said Sarah Wife of the said John Glen and to her Heirs and Assigns forever my Town Lot situate and being in the Town of Savannah aforesaid late the property of Thomas Lee deceased butting and Bounding to the Eastward on Bull Street and to the North on Square known in the plan of the said Town by the number one — Item I Give and Devise unto my Grandson John Jones (Son of the said Noble Wimberly Jones) and to his Heirs and Assigns All that Island of Marsh situate and being about four miles to the Eastward of the said Town of Savannah containing four hundred Acres, be the same more or less, purchased by me of the Honourable Grey Elliott of the Parish of Christ Church in the said Province And also I Give and Devise to my said Grandson John Jones his Heirs and Assigns all that Piece or parcel of Land containing eight acres and an half being the Garden Lot Number thirty nine and part of the Garden Lot Number Forty two East of the said Town of Savannah purchased by me of his said Excellency James Wright Esquire by certain Indentures of Lease and Release bearing date respectively the thirty first day of August and first day of September one thousand seven hundred and Sixty four. Item I Give to my Grand Sons John Jones and George Jones — Sons of the said Noble Wimberly Jones and to their respective Heirs and Assigns forever as Tenants in Common all that my Tract of Land containing One thousand Acres in the Parish

of Saint Matthew in the said Province Item I Give Devise and Bequeath to my Son Inigo Jones all that Tract of Land containing Four hundred and thirty seven Acres in the Province aforesaid and Parish of Christ Church adjoining Marsh of the Isle of Hope (in lieu of Fifty Acres of Land near Colonel Harris's formerly intended by me for my said Son Inigo) and also my Town Lot in Hardwicke known by the number twelve and also an Island of Marsh containing Eight hundred Acres more or less originally granted to me being in the River Savannah below the Town with their and each of their Rights members and appurtenances In trust Nevertheless and to and for the proper use Benefit and behoof of the Children of the said Inigo Jones and their and each of their several and respective Heirs and assigns forever Also I Give and Bequeath to my said Son Inigo Jones in trust for his Children as aforesaid, the following negroe Slaves To wit, Tom, Venture, Bynah, Clarinda, Jack, Toney, Quamina, Aaron, and Monimia, and the future Issue and Increase of the said Female Slaves, and I Do hereby direct That the said Several negroe Slaves be equally divided among the Children of my said Son Inigo as they respectively attain the Age of Twenty one years or intermarry which shall first happen, Item I Give Devise and Bequeath to Sarah the Daughter of the said Inigo Jones and to her Heirs and assigns


forever all that Town Lot in the Town of Savannah aforesaid containing Sixty feet in front and Ninety feet in Depth known by the number two in the fourth Tything Anson ward with the appurtenances And also the Farm Lot thereto belonging containing Forty-five acres Situate in the Fourth Tything Anson ward which said Town and Farm Lots were originally granted to me on the Sixteenth day of January one thousand Seven hundred and fifty six Also I give to my said Grand Daughter Sarah a negroe Girl Slave named Hanah Also I give Devise and Bequeath to my Grand Son Noble Jones son of the said Inigo Jones all that Tract of Land containing Four hundred and Fifty acres Situate and being in the Parish of Saint Andrew in the said Province originally granted to the said Inigo Jones and by him sold and conveyed to me, to have and to hold the said Tract of Land with the appurtenances to the said Noble Jones his Heirs and assigns. Item I give and Bequeath to my Grand Daughter Mary the Daughter of the said Inigo Jones a negroe Girl named Nanny with her future Issue and Increase on Condition that the said Inigo Jones shall permit the said Mary to abide with and be under the tuition and direction of my Daughter Mary and on Condition Also That my said Son Inigo Jones shall permit and suffer the said Negroe Girl Slave to stay with my said

Daughter Mary untill my said Grand-Daughter Mary shall arrive to the Age of Twenty one years or Intermarry which shall first happen -

Item I Give Devise and Bequeath To my Grand-Son Edward Jones Son of the said Noble Wimberly Jones and to his Heirs and assigns two wharf Lots in the Town of Savannah aforesaid situate and being under the Bluff of the said Town and fronting the Lots on the way before given to my Daughter Mary Item I Give and Bequeath to my Grand Daughter Catharine Daughter of the said Noble Wimberly Jones a negroe Girl named Clarinda, Item I Give to the Youngest Daughter of my said Son Noble Wimberly Jones (now living) a negroe Girl named Venus with her future Issue and Increase Item I Give and Bequeath to Sarah the wife of the said Noble Wimberly Jones a negroe Girl named Rose with her future Issue and Increase Item I Give and Bequeath to Margaret the Daughter of John Glen Esquire a negroe Girl named Phillis and To Sarah the Daughter of the said John Glen a negroe Girl named Donah with their future Issue and Increase Also I Give Devise and Bequeath to James Glen Son of the said John Glen and to his Heirs and assigns for ever all that Tract of Land containing Five hundred acres situate and being in the said Parish of Saint Andrew originally granted to me Also I Give and



Bequeath to My said Son Noble Wimperly  
 -ly and Inigo Jones my Swords fire  
 Arms and Accoutrements to be equally di-  
 -vided between them and Lastly I Give  
 Devise and Bequeath all the rest residue  
 and remainder of my Estate Real and per-  
 -sonal moneys and Securities for money of  
 what nature or kind soever and wheresoever  
 unto my said Son Noble Wimperly Jones and  
 Daughter Mary Jones to be equally divided  
 between them Share and Share alike and  
 to their respective heirs Executors Adminis-  
 -trators and assigns forever And I do here-  
 -by Constitute Nominate and Appoint the  
 said Noble Wimperly and Mary Jones Execu-  
 -tor and Executrix of this my Will hereby Re-  
 -voking all former wills by me at any time  
 heretofore made and Declare this to be my  
 Last Will and Testament In Witness  
 whereof I the said Noble Jones have hereunto  
 set my hand and Seal this twelfth day of  
 October in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 seven hundred and Seventy five.
